



Instructions for Consigning Airfreight to Australia March 2009

Australian Customs requires lodgement of impending arrival of air freighted cargo at least 4 hours prior to the first Australian Port of Call. **Failure to comply can result in a heavy fine of AUD1320.00.** Please also note that this includes weekends, so if you have cargo leaving your country for Australia between Friday night and Monday morning Australian time, we will require pre-alerts on the Friday during normal Australian business hours.

How to Cut the MAWB

When consigning airfreight to Australia, the MAWB must be consigned as follows:
